

Small Groups – Sermon Discussion Question Guide

This Discussion offers small groups two options for engaging with Holy Scripture.

- (1) Discuss the passage of scripture from the sermon this past Sunday.
- (2) Discuss the passage of scripture which will be preached upon this coming Sunday.

(1) DISCUSS LAST SUNDAY'S SCRIPTURE & SERMON

Opening Prayer

Read the text of the lesson from Sunday two to three times.

- 1. Hearing the passage again, what from the passage or sermon really jumps out as surprising or insightful or true?
- 2. Was there a word, image, or story from the passage or sermon which stayed with you?
- 3. What is the one thing from the passage or the sermon which you were most hoping we would talk about together as a small group?
- 4. Where is the pinch? Do you struggle with anything contained in this passage or in the sermon?
- 5. Where is God speaking to you in this?
- 6. How can we pray for you?

Close with Compline.

(2) DISCUSS THIS SUNDAY'S SCRIPTURE & SERMON

Opening Prayer

Read the text of the lesson from Sunday two to three times.

- 1. Reflecting on these verses, what is most clear and true?
- 2. What is most challenging in these verses? Encouraging? New?
- 3. If these verses had an impact on our culture today, what would change?
- 4. What are you hoping the preacher will include in the sermon?
- 5. Where is the pinch? Do you struggle with anything contained in this passage?
- 6. Where is God speaking to you?
- 7. How can we pray for you?
